

WHITE	
Vistamar Brisa Sauvignon Blanc, Chile	£14.10
Citrus, apples, a touch of grass. Very crisp and clean - exactly what you want from this grape.	
Bodegas Ciceron, Larrades Rioja Blanco, Spain	£14.85
Rioja is not just confined to reds; white Rioja is growing in popularity. This wine is highly aromatic with a rich nose of apples and pears, citrus and tropical fruit; a fruity wine with fresh acidity.	
Le Magnolie, Pinot Grigio, Italy	£14.85
Heaps of flavour is locked in to this Pinot Grigio as a result of the vineyard's high altitude which gives way to crisp, refreshing acidity.	
Dowie Doole, Hunt, Chardonnay, Australia	£15.30
A rounded white from a premium McLaren Vale producer. Apples and melons complexed by partial oak fermentation followed by a crisp, lingering finish.	
Pecorino, Terre di Chieti IGT, Italy	£15.75
Usually reserved for cheese, here it is in wine form made from the Pecorino grape. The nose complex with smells of exotic fruits and soft notes of spices. On the palate well structured with pleasant acidity.	
Domaine de la Motte, Chablis, France	£19.20
A rich and lovely Chardonnay from the International Wine Challenge French Producer of the Year.	
RED	
Vistamar Brisa Merlot, Chile	£14.30
Ripe plum and blackberries on the palate leading to a soft and moreish finish.	
Bodegas Ciceron, Larrades Rioja Crianza, Spain	£15.70
The palate is soft, warm and creamy (does anyone remember strawberry swirls?) with roasted coffee notes from its time spent in French oak barriques.	
Dowie Doole, Hunt Shiraz, Australia	£15.30
McLaren Vale is best known for premium Shiraz and established producer Dowie Doole has crafted an approachable style. Red berry and liquorice aromas with cedar and wood smoke. Spicy plum and mocha flavours enhanced by French oak maturation.	
Pablo y Walter Malbec, Argentina	£15.50
A really pure expression of Malbec, bright red and juicy, rich chocolate flavours with a lick of oak to round out the edges.	
Cantina Tombacco, Biferno Rosso Riserva (Montepulciano) DOC	£16.20
Biferno is home to the wonderfully fruity grape, Montepulciano. The wine has appreciated after time spent ageing in both barrel and bottle and the result is an aromatic wine with cherry and floral lift, but a deep plum and liquorice richness of fruit with mellow tannins.	
Domaine Raspail-ay, Gigondas, 2011	£19.30
Dense blackcurrant, kirsch and mineral notes intermixed with hints of cigar box and forest floor. Bold, delicious stuff.	
ROSE	
Discovery Beach Zinfandel Blush, California	£14.80
A fantastic rosé from California's flagship variety. A refreshing palate of summer berry fruits and ripe watermelon.	
SPARKLING	
Le Magnolie Prosecco Extra Dry NV Spumante	£19.60
Higher altitude vineyard location and small scale production ensures refreshing, dry acidity which locks in flavour unlike mass produced versions. Look forward to a touch of natural sweetness and bubbles that last.	
Charles Chevalier Brut Premier NV	£22.00
A fine champagne made in the classic tradition of the champagne houses of Ay, principally Pinot Noir and Chardonnay with some Pinot Meunier and matured in cool chalk cellars for five years before release.	
R.C Lemaire, Champagne Cuvée Trianon	£43.00
Roger Constant Lemaire is a small family run Champagne House located in the Marne Valley. They have been producing quality Champagne for 5 generations. . Cuvée Trianon a blend of 60% Pinot Noir and 40% Chardonnay.
