



WHITE

Vistamar Brisa Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

£17.95

Citrus, apples, a touch of grass. Very crisp and clean - exactly what you want from this grape.

Cape Heights Chenin Blanc, South Africa

£18.50

This wine displays classic baked apple and zippy citrus aromas with soft, delicate apple fruit on the palate balanced by crisp acidity. Extended lees contact gives this great value wine some real weight and character, the barrel fermented component adds texture and finesse too.

Le Magnolie, Pinot Grigio, Italy

£19.95

Heaps of flavour is locked into this Pinot Grigio as a result of the vineyard's high altitude which gives way to crisp, refreshing acidity.

The Last Stand Chardonnay, Australia

£20.50

Refreshingly unoaked, citrus and white peach flavours combine with a zesty fresh acidity and a clean, bright and linear mineral finish.

Monte Schiavo Ruviano Verdicchio Classico [Organic], Italy

£21.95

Fresh zesty nose with apricot and orchard fruit aromas, and a hint of white flower and citrus. The palate has minerality and texture with ripe stone fruit and grapefruit characters, refreshing lemon citrus acidity, a touch of salinity, and a crisp finish.

Novas Gran Reserva Riesling, [Organic], Chile

£23.95

Quietly complex on the nose with fresh lime notes combining with a steely minerality and gentle honeysuckle flora. The palate is mid-weight and off-dry with persistent flavours of lime, there is a natural salinity which gives contrast yet lovely balance. It finishes clean with a lingering flinty character.

Domaine de la Combe, Muscadet Sèvre & Maine Sur Lie, France

£27.95

Flinty, lightly mineral with apple fruit and real texture and interest. The old vine fruit adds amazing depth and mineral complexity to this fresh, savoury wine that has so much more to it than you might expect from Muscadet.



RED

Vistamar Brisa Merlot, Chile **£17.95**

Ripe plum and blackberries on the palate leading to a soft and moreish finish. Very drinkable.

Pianteferro Primitivo, Italy **£18.95**

Ripe fruity notes of plum and blackcurrant jam combined with spicy notes of black pepper & rosemary. Warm and full-bodied mouth feel with great persistence followed by spicy and almond notes to finish.

The Last Stand Shiraz, Australia **£20.50**

This attractively fruity Shiraz in a cooler-climate style has concentrated mulberry and black pepper notes combined with soft plummy fruit flavours and smooth savoury tannins.

Don Aparo Malbec, Argentina **£21.95**

Colourful and lightly perfumed with big, juicy blackberry flavours, and overtones of plum and black cherry.

Les Volets Pinot Noir, Pays de la Haute Vallée de l'Aude, France **£23.95**

Bright ruby red, with upfront aromas of freshly picked raspberries and an underlying savoury leesiness. Fleshy red fruits continue to the palate and are joined by fine tannins and juicy acidity - the foundations of a serious Pinot Noir.

Larrades Crianza, Spain **£24.50**

Red and black berries perfectly blended with vanilla, cacao, anise and coconut notes. It appears smooth, warm, lush and unctuous. Notes of berries blended with coffee and toasty flavours merge. It is a full-bodied round wine with a long finish.

Château Baron Bellevue, France **£28.95**

Classic Bordeaux, ripe, soft and spicy with wild bramble flavours, tasty tannins and a lovely gutsy character. Aged for 18 months in the Château's cellars.



ROSE

Discovery Beach Zinfandel Blush, California **£18.95**

A fantastic rosé from California's flagship variety. A refreshing palate of summer berry fruits and ripe watermelon.

Il Caggio Pinot Grigio Blush, Italy **£19.95**

Lovely berry fruit characters on the nose and palate - a fresh and enjoyable rose. A dry, fresh and fruity rose with delicate aromas of red berries. Crisp and lively on the palate with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit.

Caprice, Provence, France **£24.95**

A showstopper – such a delicate, shimmering, pale pink that it's hard to believe there could be any weight or flavour at all. But then rich and powerful in the mouth with notes of strawberry, cranberry, fresh herb and anise all clean and crisp and creamy.

SPARKLING

Le Magnolie Prosecco Extra Dry NV Spumante **£25.95**

Higher altitude vineyard location and small-scale production ensures refreshing, dry acidity which locks in flavour unlike mass produced versions. Look forward to a touch of natural sweetness and bubbles that last.

Montesor Prosecco Rosé Extra Dry, Italy **£26.95**

Gentle berry and citrus aromas. The palate has lightly honeyed, apple characters with a touch of redcurrant. Some appealing weight and texture balanced by crisp acidity, a persistent mousse and good length.

Charles Chevalier Brut Premier NV **£49.95**

A fine Champagne made in the classic tradition of the Champagne houses of Ay, principally Pinot Noir and Chardonnay with some Pinot Meunier and matured in cool chalk cellars for five years before release.

Louis Roederer Brut Premier NV, France **£55.00**

The freshness, finesse, and brightness of Brut Premier make it the perfect wine for festive occasions. Its structured texture, richness, and length are distinctly winery. It is a full, complex wine that is both rich and powerful, whilst remaining a great classic.



DESSERT WINE

Ginestet Classique Sauternes (50cl)

£27.95

A classic botrytis nose; rich in honey and sweet floral tones with hints of citrus marmalade. The palate is rich and smooth with similar sweet floral and honeyed apricot flavours but with a faintly citrus note in the finish which makes it very moreish.

Château Carcanieux, Cru Bourgeois Médoc 2015, France

£42.00

Vines average 25 years of age and grow on particularly gravelly and sandy, free-draining soil within 23ha of Château Carcanieux's 40ha Médoc estate. Cabernet Sauvignon (45%), Merlot (40%), Cabernet Franc (10%) and Petit Verdot (5%) are vinified in stainless steel tanks and aged oak barrels, with no more than a fifth in new oak. Ripe cassis fruit, oak spice and a leafy note to the ripe tannins. Gently feral and showing a hint of maturity, the sous bois-flavoured finish is long and spicy with a lingering, fruity core.

La Colombaia Amarone della Valpolicella 2015, Italy

£52.00

Ripe, warm and generous on the nose with abundant plum and cherry aromas, roasted coffee beans and hints of dried fruits. Full bodied and richly flavoured with berry and plum fruit, wild cherry acidity and a hint of dark chocolate. Supple tannins lead to a spicy finish, with the characteristic dry bite of good Amarone. A balanced and very approachable style.
