Champagne & Sparkling Wine

Henners Brut NV

£60

Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, grown on both clay and neighbouring grower's chalk soils which complement each other in terms of generosity and finesse.

Aged on lees for 3 years it is an elegant, refined wine with great balance and a delicious citrus and orchard fruit backbone.

England

Charles Chevalier Brut NV £50

The vines are mainly planted in shallow soil overlaying chalk which encourages the roots to grow deeply into the chalk, providing them with water and warmth. The Pinot Noir vineyard in Aÿ has a sunny south facing slope, which enables the grapes to reach excellent maturity. Apple, stone fruits, with light notes of brioche, toast and cream.

Cashew nuts, almonds and peppermint. On the palate, the white fruits are dense and pulpy supported by a slightly lemony finish.

Le Magnolie Prosecco

Fine and persistent bubbles, fresh fruit and white flowers on the palate. Italy

Novas Gran Reserva £24.95/£5.50 Riesling

Quietly complex on the nose with fresh lime notes combining with a steely minerality and gentle honeysuckle flora. The palate is mid-weight and off-dry with persistent flavours of lime, there is a natural salinity which gives contrast yet lovely balance. It finishes clean with a lingering flinty character. Chile

Last Stand Chardonnay £20.5 / £5.60

A crisp, unoaked Chardonnay brimming with citrus fruits such as tangerine, grapefruit and lime. Made from low-yielding vines which produce grapes with highly concentrated flavours. This is a great partner to an array of dishes. Australia

Cuvée Jean Paul Gascogne Blanc de Blancs £23.95 / £6

A fresh nose of lime, basil, freshly cut green grass and guavas. The medium-bodied palate continues with more green fruits and flowers; figs and tobacco flowers.

Vistamar Sauvignon Blanc £20.50/£5.50

Expressive on the nose with green apple, pineapple and fresh fruit aromas. Fresh, clean and fruity on the palate with well - balanced acidity and a pleasant finish. Really easy to drink and it's not hard to see why this is one of our very bestsellers.

Rose

Discovery White Zinfandel £21/£6.00

A youthful wine with aromas of fresh cherries and watermelon. On the palate, flavours of juicy ripe strawberries and sweet candy are incredibly sumptuous and ever so moreish.

USA

Verdicchio dei Castelli £26

Verdicchio is one of Italy's finest white grape varieties, and this example has great precision and tension with grapefruit-peel and flint notes that hold well on the refreshing dry finish. Italy

Vieilles Vignes Muscadet £27

Flinty, lightly mineral with appley fruit and real texture and interest. The old vine fruit adds amazing depth and mineral complexity to this fresh, savoury wine that has so much more to it than you might expect from Muscadet. France

CAPRICE ROSÉ PROVENCE £25

Red fruits push through the citrus and grapefruit acidity to give a creamy, ripe wine, the palate is soft and complex. France

Le Magnolie Pinot Grigio £19.95/£5.50

Perfect example of this classic wine and Le Magnolie's vineyards at high altitude makes for its dry, crisp taste with a finely balanced acidity and heaps of flavor. Italy

Red

Piantaferro Primitivo £19.95/£5.50

An enveloping warm and full bodied mouth feel with great persistence followed by spicy and almond notes to finish.

Great with roasted, grilled and barbecued red meats, game and venison. Also pairs well with tuna & swordfish steaks and seasoned semi mature hard cheeses. Italy

Don Aparo Malbec £22.95/£5.80

Jewel like colour, with a light spiced nose, with generous blackberry, plum and cherry flavours.

Don Aparo rode his bicycle 14km everyday to visit and tend his beloved vineyard.

Chile

Vistamar Brisa Merlot £18.95/£5.50

This wine is deep red in colour with violet highlights. It offers intense aromas of red fruits and plums, overlaid with pleasant notes of wood. It tastes fruity on the palate, with rounded tannins, which, together with a delicious acidity, go to make up a long, delightful finish with plenty of mature fruits. Chile

Gigondas: Domaine Raspail- £85 Ay 2019

Made from a majority of Grenache, this most impressive wine is powerful and truly mouth watering. Red fruit notes with a long palate and lingering mature tannins.

Les Volets Pinot Noir, Pays de la Haute Vallée de l'Aude

Rich, savoury and luscious.

LA COLOMBAIA AMARONE £40

Ripe, warm and generous on the nose with plum and cherry aromas and hints of dried fruits. Full bodied and richly flavoured with rich berry and plum fruit, supple tannins and a spicy finish, with the characteristic dry bite of good Amarone.

CHATEAU BARON £26 BELLEVUE, COTES DE BOURG

Classic Bourg: gutsy, spicy and very approachable. Mainly Merlot, this is typically ripe and spicy with wild bramble flavours, tasty tannins and a lovely gutsy character. France

MonteVista Carmenere £26

A wine with poise, elegance and restraint. The nose has plenty of ripe and meaty notes with plum, cherry and bramble fruit aromas.

New vintage of what used to be called Andes Peaks. Always a very dependable and well balanced wine.

Chile

Chateau Carcanieux Cru £60 Bourgeois Médoc Bordeaux

Aromatic berry fruit, complex oak spice and a leafy note to the ripe tannins. Gently savoury and showing a hint of maturity, the sous bois-flavoured finish is long and spicy with a lingering, fruity core.

Cabernet Sauvignon 45%, Merlot 40%, Cabernet Franc 10% France
